## About.

Keeping Safe Together offers a new, whole of family therapeutic case management support program for families who have been impacted by family violence in Melbourne's west.

The Keeping Safe Together team works with all family members, including men, to minimise risk and harm to women and children and allows families to heal, recover and live a life free from violence.

## Who can Keeping Safe Together help?

Keeping Safe Together is for families who have experienced and are recovering from family violence and who are living in the metropolitan region of Melbourne.

## Keeping Safe Together may benefit a variety of families, including:

- Families where both parents are willing to engage and participate
- Families with children
- Same sex families
- Families who want to stay together
- Separated families who wish to improve co-parenting

## Keeping Safe Together can help by:

- Supporting mothers to keep themselves and their children safe when they choose to remain with their partner
- Working with fathers to end the violence and keep their partner and children safe
- Working with the whole family to develop goals they wish to achieve as a family
- Supporting parents and children individually to improve family functioning, heal, recover and work towards a life free from violence
- Working with separated families to build healthy co-parenting arrangements
- Supporting the unique needs of same sex families

## What support families can expect to receive:

- Information and education on parenting and the impact of violence
- Family goal setting
- Home visits
- One-on-one specialist therapeutic support for family members
- Facilitated family group sessions
- Access to group work programs
- Access to flexible after hours support
- Coordinated referral to other support services
- No cost to families

## Referral process:

Keeping Safe Together program is available to assist families from 9am-5pm on Monday, Thursday and Friday and 11.30am-7.30pm on Tuesday and Wednesday.
